Art. 1 Purpose of the directive

The aim of this directive is to set the conditions for granting parental scholarships to students in doctoral study programmes at CTU FEE. The intention is to support FEE doctoral students caring for children under 3 years of age. This measure complements other similar tools (return grants, family support tools, university nurseries and planned children's groups at CTU). Among other things, the aim is to reduce the academic failure rate of doctoral students at FEE in connection with caring for minor children.

Art. 2 Basic rules

- 2.1 The scholarship is awarded on the basis of an application submitted by the student.
- 2.2 Applicants for the scholarship must meet the following conditions:
- be a student of a doctoral study programme at CTU FEE in full-time or part-time form,
 - have submitted an application for a scholarship (form attached to this directive),
 - cares for a child under 3 years of age (proven by presenting the child's birth certificate),
 - is not in an employment or similar labour-law relationship with a workload exceeding 0.7 FTE,
 - according to the latest semester evaluation, fulfils the study obligations specified in the individual study plan,
 - is not subject to proceedings for termination of studies or disciplinary proceedings.
- 2.3 The scholarship is paid monthly in the amount of CZK 5,000.
- 2.4 The scholarship may be awarded for each child who meets the above conditions, provided that only one of the child's parents may receive this support in a given month.
- 2.5 This support cannot be combined with other CTU support related to parenthood (Family Support Tool, Return Grants, CTU Children's Group, etc.).

Art. 3 Awarding and revocation of the scholarship

The dean of the faculty decides on the awarding of the scholarship based on an application submitted by doctoral students. Entitlement to a scholarship expires upon the dean's decision



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or failure to meet the above conditions. Students who are awarded a scholarship are obliged to inform the FEE Office for Science and Research without undue delay (within 7 days at the latest) of any changes that may affect their eligibility for the scholarship.
